

# PORT UISITS



### VISIT TO SEA PORT, GUJRAT

The Department of International Business at JIMS Technical Campus, Rohini, organized a sea port visit for first-year PGDM IB students to Mundra (Adani) Port, Gujarat, on Feb 22, 2024. # GUEST SESSIONS



#### GLOBAL SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT : OPPORTUNITY AND CHALLENGES DR. PRASHANT N. BHARDWAJ, PENNSYLVANIA

Dr. Prashanth N. #### FINANCIAL STATEMENT ANALYSIS AND CREDIT ANALYSIS 9TH MAR 2024




